Example: Rudolph the red ~~eared~~**nosed** reindeer.

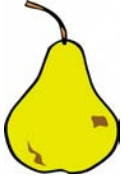
Rudolph, the red-nosed reindeer

play in any reindeer **games/ activities**.

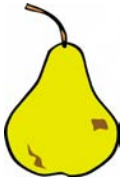
Then one foggy Christmas eve

Color the **small** bunny brown. Color the **big** bunny yellow.

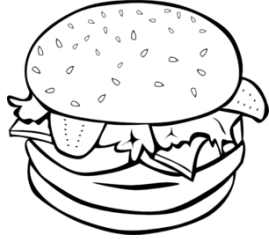
Color the **small** chick pink. Color the **big** chick yellow.

**What's missing?** Draw what's missing and color the pictures.

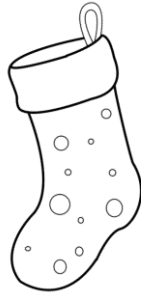

What's missing? **The fries.**



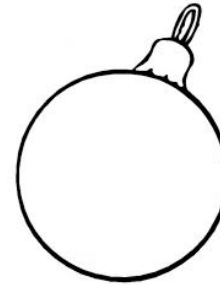
What's here? Santa Claus.  
What's missing? **The presents.**



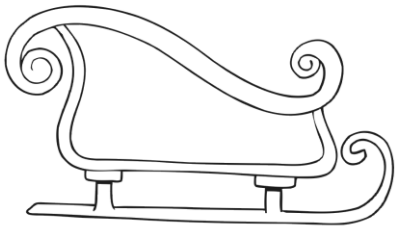
What's here? The stocking.
